V. THE NEW COVENANT

Justification. Zech. 12:10, "I will pour on the house of David, and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications, and they will look on me whom they have pierced, and they will mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son. ... In that day there will be a great mourning in Jerusalem. ... And the land will mourn, every family apart; the family of the house of David apart. and their wives apart; the family of the house of Nathan apart, and their wives apart; ... In that day there will be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness."

Sanctification. Joel 2:28, "It will come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions."

Glorification. Is. 60:2-3, "Darkness will cover the earth, ... but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will be seen on you, and the Gentiles will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising."

Ez. 20:4-21, "I will scatter you among the heathen, and disperse you in the countries. ... Because you have all become dross, behold, therefore I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem. ... I gather you in my anger and in my fury [the Holocaust], and I will leave you there [in Jerusalem], and melt you. Yes, I will gather you, and blow on you in the fire of my wrath, and you will be melted in the midst of it.

SECOND & LAST WORLD-WIDE REGATHERING (POST-TRIB) (COMPLETE)

Zech. 14:2-4, "I will gather all Gentile nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city will be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city will go forth into captivity. ... Then will the Lord go forth, and fight against those Gentile nations. ... And his feet will stand in that day on the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east.

Mt. 24:29-31, "Immediately after the tribulation of those days ... they will see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven. ... And he will send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together his elect [Israel] ... from one end of heaven to the other.

Is. 11:6-12. The wolf also will dwell with the lamb, and ... the calf and the young lion. ... The earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea. ... In that day, ... the Lord will set his hand again the **SECOND** time to recover the remnant of his people, which will be left, from Assyria, [etc.] ... and from the islands of the sea. And he will ... gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Rom. 11:26, "And so ALL Israel will be saved."

II. THE MOSAIC COV. (THE LAW)

1) Life for Obedience

Lev. 18:5, "You shall therefore keep my statutes ... which if a man do, he shall live in them."

2) Death for Disobedience

Deut. 27:26, "Cursed be he that confirms not all the words of this law to do them."

Jews Will Be Judged by the Law, Gentiles By Righteousness

Rom. 2:14-15. As many as have sinned without law [the Gentiles] will also perish without law, and as many as have sinned in the law [the Jews] will be judged by the law. ... For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these ... show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness.

Messiah Was Judged for Us: Gal. 3:10-17, "Messiah has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, 'Cursed is every one that hangs on a tree,' so that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Messiah; so that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through <u>faith</u>. ... And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Messiah, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect."

Unbelievers Will Receive Differing Amounts of Punishment: Rev. 20. The rest of the dead didn't live again until the thousand years were finished. ... And when the thousand years [were] expired, ... I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened, and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their <u>works</u>. ... This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Believers Will Receive Differing Amounts of Rewards: 1 Cor. 3:11-15, "Other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Messiah. Now if any man build on this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble. ... If any man's <u>work</u> abide ..., he will receive a reward. If any man's <u>work</u> will be burned, he will suffer loss, but he himself will be saved, yet so as by fire.
