(THE LAW)</b></p> <p><b>1) National World Dominance and Other Physical Blessings for Obedience</b> Deut. 28:1-10, “<b>If</b> you will hearken diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, to observe and to do <u>all</u> his commandments which I command you this day, that the Lord thy God will set you on high above all nations of the earth. Blessed you will be in the city, and blessed you will be in the field. [etc.]</p> <p><b>2) The Diaspora and Other Physical Cursings for Disobedience</b> Deut. 28:15-19, “<b>But</b> ... <b>if</b> you will not hearken to the voice of the Lord your God, to observe to do <u>all</u> his commandments and his statutes which I command you this day: ... Cursed you will be in the city, and cursed you will be in the field. [etc.] ... You will be plucked from off the land where you go to possess it. Yes, I will gather you, and blow on you in the fire of my wrath, and you will be melted in the midst of it.</p> <p><b>SECOND &amp; LAST WORLD-WIDE REGATHERING (POST-TRIB) (COMPLETE)</b>                      Zech. 14:2-4, "I will gather all Gentile nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city will be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city will go forth into captivity. ... Then will the Lord go forth, and fight against those Gentile nations. ... And his feet will stand in that day on the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east.</p> <p>Mt. 24:29-31, "Immediately after the tribulation of those days ... they will see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven. ... And he will send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together his elect [Israel] ... from one end of heaven to the other.</p> <p>Is. 11:6-12. <p><b>1) Life for Obedience</b> Lev. 18:5, “You shall therefore keep my statutes ... which if a man do, he shall live in them.”</p> <p><b>2) Death for Disobedience</b> Deut. 27:26, “Cursed be he that confirms not all the words of this law to do them.”</p> <p><b>Jews Will Be Judged by the Law, Gentiles By Righteousness</b> Rom. 2:14-15. As many as have sinned without law [the Gentiles] will also perish without law, and as many as have sinned in the law [the Jews] will be judged by the law. ... For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these ... show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness.</p> <p><b>Messiah Was Judged for Us:</b> Gal. 3:10-17, “Messiah has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, ‘Cursed is every one that hangs on a tree,’ so that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Messiah; so that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through <u>faith</u>. ... And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Messiah, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect.”</p> <p><b>Unbelievers Will Receive Differing Amounts of Punishment:</b> Rev. 20. The rest of the dead didn’t live again until the thousand years were finished. ... And when the thousand years [were] expired, ... I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened, and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their <u>works</u>. ... This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.</p> <p><b>Believers Will Receive Differing Amounts of Rewards:</b> 1 Cor. 3:11-15, “Other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Messiah. Now if any man build on this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble. ... If any man's <u>work</u> abide ..., he will receive a reward. SECOND &amp; LAST WORLD-WIDE REGATHERING (POST-TRIB) (COMPLETE)</b> Ez. 20:34-42, “I ... will gather you out of the countries where you are scattered, ... and I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there I will plead with you face to face. ... And I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant, and I will purge out from among you the rebels. ... I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they will not enter into the land of Israel. ... For in ... the mountain of the height of Israel, ... there will ALL the house of Israel, ALL of them in the land, serve me. ... And you will know that I am the Lord, when I will bring you into the land of Israel, into the country for the which I lifted up mine hand to give it to your fathers.</p>	<p><b>IV. DAVIDIC COV. NEW COVENANT PERSONAL</b> <b>Justification.</b> Mt. 26:27-28, “He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, ‘Drink all of it, for this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for <u>the remission of sins</u>.’”</p> <p><b>Sanctification.</b> Acts 1:5, “You will be <u>baptized with the Holy Spirit</u> not many days from now.” Gal. 5:22, “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, ...”</p> <p><b>Glorification.</b> 1 Cor. 15:51-52, “We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump; for the trumpet will sound, and <u>the [bodies of the] dead will be raised</u> incorruptible, and we will be changed.”</p>
